Job Profile

The candidate should be familiar with work relating to matters concerning general administration, establishment and accounts, such as carrying our administrative functions related to filing of papers, attending calls, organizing meetings, providing consular related services, preparing statements of accounts, seeking quotations, visiting outside the Frankfurt city for consular camps, perform protocol duties at Frankfurt airport etc. for various works to be under

taken at the Consulate, any other duties as directed from time to time. The candidate may be called upon exigencies of works on holidays or outside office hours based on exigencies. The candidate may be required to perform duties outside office hours.
